Direction and Gate Stewards	Various time shifts throughout the day. Assisting the trade stand co-ordinator directing trade stands on and off the showground and to their allocated pitch area. Working on the showground ensuring emergency gates are attended.	Able to stand for long periods
Cattle or Sheep Steward	Co-ordinating with livestock secretaries. Ring steward, helping judges, organising competitors, overseeing classes.	A good knowledge of handling and working around cattle or sheep. Ability to stand for long periods of time.
Equine Steward	Help support the equine secretary and her team.	Physically able and a good knowledge of handling and working around horses.
Main Arena Assistant	Help co-ordinate the main ring attractions.	Ability to stand for long periods of time.

Gate Entrance Steward	Working as part of a team scanning tickets on entry.	A degree of skill using our scanners. Ability to stand for long periods of time.
Car Park Stewards	Working as part of a team directing on site visitor traffic within the car park.	Ability to stand for long periods of time.
Discovery Barn Assistant	Assist with the educational related activities.	
Homecraft Tent Assistant	Working alongside other assistants helping the Homecraft Secretary & judges.	Ability to stand for long periods of time.
Show Secretary Assistant	Assist the show secretary both with enquiries, liaising amongst sections and other such tasks.	Able to get around the showground on foot.
Judges Meet & Greet	To meet the judges and act as liaison between the section heads and judges.	Physically able
Runners	Assisting the show secretary and all the various sections.	Able to get around the showground on foot.

Show Take Down Assistant	Various tasks the day after the show. Working as part of a team gathering up all the equipment, stacking barriers, collecting up signs, litter picking.	Physically able
Show Administration	Collating results, uploading information, correspondence and communications.	Ability to use word and excel.
